SEMESTER & YEAR-LONG PROGRAM COSTS

Exchange
with Partner Universities

PAID TO BELMONT:

1. TUITION

- Full time (12-18 credits) or per credit if < 12
- Additional credits (if over 18)

2. STUDENT FEE

INDIRECT COSTS NOT PAID TO BELMONT:

- Housing/Meals
- Airfare
- Books & Supplies
- Incidental expenses, optional excursions & independent travel

PAID TO BELMONT:

1. TUITION

- Full time (12-18 credits) or per credit if < 12
- Additional credits (if over 18)

2. STUDENT FEE

3. PROGRAM FEE

- Housing
- Most meals
- Orientation/excursions

INDIRECT COSTS NOT PAID TO BELMONT:

- Airfare
- Books & Supplies,
- Incidental expenses, independent travel, & additional meals

MAYMESTER & SUMMMER PROGRAMS

PAID TO BELMONT:

1. TUITION

- Discounted tuition by $2/3^*$
(Ex: 3 credits for price of 1 credit)
*This only applies to study abroad courses!

2. STUDENT FEE

3. PROGRAM FEE

- Includes:
 - Housing & most meals
 - Airfare
 - Excursions
 - Administrative work



- Payment plans (NelNet) CAN be used!
- Belmont aid, scholarships, grants CANNOT be used
- Federal aid (PELL, HOPE, or loans) CAN be used ONLY if enrolled in 6+ credit hours

MAYMESTER & SUMMER PAYMENT NOTICES

BILLING STATEMENTS:

For Maymester = Start of April

For Summer = Start of May



PAYMENT DUE DATES:

For Maymester = End of April

For Summer = End of May



FINAL DEADLINE:

STUDENT ACCOUNT BALANCE MUST BE PAID BEFORE DEPARTING FOR PROGRAM!

EXAMPLE CHARGES #1

A MAYMESTER OR SUMMER PROGRAM...

A STUDENT TAKES 6 CREDIT HOURS...

1. Tuition = \$3,060.00

○ How?

- 1 credit hour = \$1,530.00 x 6 credits = \$9,180.00
- DISCOUNT applied: $\$9,180.00/3 = \underline{\$3,060.00}$

2. Student Fee = \$275.00

3. Program Fee = \$5,500.00 (estimated)

TOTAL = \$8,835.00

EXAMPLE CHARGES #2

A FALL/SPRING SEMESTER EXCHANGE PROGRAM...

A STUDENT TAKES 12 CREDIT HOURS...

1. Tuition = \$20,280.00 (Full-time)

- + \$1,530.00 per additional credit taken

2. Student Fee = \$990.00

3. Program Fee = \$5,500.00 (estimated)

*Some programs will not have this additional program fee

TOTAL = \$26,160.00

IMPORTANT STUDY ABROAD FAQS:

- Program fees for Maymester/Summer range from \$2,000-8,000
- NELNET Monthly Payment Plans are AVAILABLE for Fall/Spring semester or year-long programs AND Maymester/Summer programs!
- Students who plan to use aid for Maymester/Summer **MUST** complete the Maymester/Summer Financial Aid Application found on the Student Financial Aid forms website (Released in February).
- CPoS (Course Program of Study) requirements apply to all programs and semesters of study abroad! Financial aid may be reduced based on eligible courses!

2. COMPLETE Maymester/Summer Financial Aid Application (only if applying to use Loans, PELL, or HOPE)

- **Deadline: April 1st**

- Spring - late December
- Maymester - early April
- Summer - early May

4. PAY ACCOUNT BALANCE (BEFORE DEPARTURE!)

- Spring - early January
- Maymester - end of April
- Summer - end of May
