Students must have earned a previous Bachelor's degree to be eligible for enrollment.

Students must have completed the following prerequisite courses to be eligible for enrollment:

- Microbiology (4 credit hours)
- Human Anatomy and Physiology I and II (4 credit hours each; must be taken within last 5 years)
- General Chemistry (3 credit hours)
- General Psychology (3 credit hours)
- Human Development (3 credit hours)
- Lifespan Nutrition (2 credit hours)
- Statistics (3 credit hours)
- Two Religion Courses (6 credit hours)
 - Option A – An Old Testament course (3 credit hours) and a New Testament Course (3 credit hours)
 - Option B – A Bible course which includes study of both the Old Testament and New Testament (3 credit hours) and any other Religion course (3 credit hours)
