3. Have FAFSA on file for the current aid year.

*** If you have used all of your Federal Direct Subsidized or Unsubsidized loans during the Fall/Spring, you will most likely not be eligible to use them during the Maymester/Summer. If you have not used the loans during Fall/Spring, SFS will review your eligibility to use them toward Maymester/Summer programs.
