



## Tennessee HOPE Scholarship Information page in Banner Web

The Tennessee HOPE Scholarship Information page in Banner Web allows students to monitor their eligibility and academic progress based on the guidelines developed by the state of Tennessee.

### How can I see the status of my Tennessee HOPE scholarship?

Log into Banner web and navigate to:

## How will I know if my HOPE scholarship will not be renewed?

At the end of each semester, after grades are posted, the Office of Financial Aid will determine if you have reached a checkpoint based on the number of hours you have attempted using the state-defined method for this calculation. If you have reached a checkpoint, your GPA will be calculated using the state-defined methodology and if you are below the GPA threshold or have met certain other criteria that would terminate your HOPE scholarship, this will be shown in the student Tennessee HOPE Scholarship Information page in the Banner Web Portal. You will also receive an email from the office of Financial Aid stating the reason your HOPE scholarship was terminated.
